CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Louis G. Damonte has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (trailer park) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 20, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 20° 15' 42" E. a distance of 3,596.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Louis G. Damonte
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.466 c.f.s., but not to exceed 11.55 mga
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 8, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and motor, thence conveyed to a 2000 gallon pressure tank, thence distributed through 4 inch mains and 3/4 inch service laterals to a 111-unit trailer park in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 20, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
