CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alonzo Knudsen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Burnt Creek through headgate and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 2, T.38N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 2 bears N. 9° 03' E. a distance of 2,544.00 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of Burnt Creek as heretofore granted under the Humboldt River Adjudication, Bartlett Decree, Page 147, (Proof 00214).

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
