CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James A. Finch has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an underground source

through drilled well, pump, and irrigation system for

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 29, T.13N.,

R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said

Sec. 29 bears S. 43° 08' E. a distance of 3,789.0 feet

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 21803 hence the priority of appropriation for the land under this certificate is the same as Permit 21803.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
