CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David Huntington has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

through pump, pipe and pressure tank for domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 5, Section 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Section 10 bears S 24° 26' W., a distance of 1636.7 feet.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425. has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.1825 mqa

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 30, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

water is diverted by means of a 2 H.P. pump submerged in Lake Tahoe, thence conveyed by means of a 2 inch pipe 200 feet long to a residence located within Lot 5, Section 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
