WHEREAS, Reginald G. Lee - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 29, Ch. 18, Statutes of 1907 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
