CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Peter S. Indart, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Bullrun Creek

through Dam and irrigation ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 43 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 1 bears S. 71° 50' W., a distance of 2,548.0 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Petan Company
Post-office address: Tuscarora, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 45.0 cfs, but not to exceed 6,993.0 ac.ft. per season
Period of use, from: April 1st to July 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 17, 1911

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 204.5 acres in W 1/2 of Section 2, T. 43 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

Table with 6 columns: Area, Direction, Section, Township, Range, Meridian. Rows include 640.0, 350.0, 25.5, 323.5, 36.5, 41.0, 524.0, 186.0, and a total of 2331.0 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
