CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clarence Keller has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ferguson Springs through spring, pipeline and storage tank for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 30 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 83°33' E., a distance of 1,320.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 46, Statutes of 1937 ~~2025-03-21~~ has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Willard and Leland W. Petersen and Clarence Keller  
Post-office address Ogden, Utah  
Amount of appropriation 0.10 cfs or sufficient to water 40,000 sheep  
Period of use, from November 1st to April 30th the following of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 20, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted from the spring by a 2-inch pipe to a 10,000 gallon storage tank located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, thence hauled by truck to the sheep camps where it is used for watering 40,000 sheep and for camp purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
