CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert Belzarena (Agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Stonehouse Spring through tunnel, pipeline and pond for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 33 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 31 bears S. 54° 55' W., a distance of 2,710.0 feet, situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Star Sheep Co., Inc.  
Post-office address Inlay, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.012425 cfs or sufficient to water 1500 sheep and 100 cattle  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 24, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed via tunnel drifted in spring area, thence conveyed via 200' of pipeline to mouth of spring thence via 15' of pipeline to a 50' x 4' x 12' pond located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
