CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. E. TYSON, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through drilled well, tank and distribution system for quasi-municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 25 bears S 19° 26' 00" E., 1805.15 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chap. 46, Stat. of 1937 ~~NRS 223.425~~ has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s., but not to exceed 21.824 m.g.y.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 16, 1954

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped through a distribution system to the place of use within the E 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T. 20 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for quasi-municipal purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
