CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Emil H. Miller has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump & distribution system for Commercial & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 22S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 17 bears N. 71° 57' 50" E. 315.65 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Emil H. Miller  
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.424 M.G.A.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 15, 1960

Description of Works of diversion, manner & place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to 4 apartments and a liquor store and landscaping located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is for commercial and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
