CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert G. Irvin - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Stonehouse Spring through Spring, pipe and trough for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 27N., R. 25E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 8 bears S. 84° E. a distance of 745.0 feet.

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 140, Statutes of 1913 NRS 633.03 has determined the date,

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C-Punch Corporation

Post-office address Los Angeles, California

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 cfs or sufficient to water 500 head of Cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 13, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is diverted from the spring by a box, thence piped approximately 1/4 mile to a concrete trough, 18'x10'x1.5' located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 500 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
