CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, D. Cerutti Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Blackburn Spring through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 15N., R. 49E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 3, T. 16N., R. 50E., M. D. B. & M., bears N. 52° 15' E., a distance of 16,925.0 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions Sec. 29, Ch. 18, Statutes of 1907 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.025 cfs or sufficient to water 100 head of Cattle
Period of use, from April 1st to August 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 9, 1912

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the spring by a pipeline and conveyed to stock troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 100 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*Note the number of cattle taken from ltr. -2-21-72, Period of use from book record, diversion from PBU.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
