

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. E. Kimball-Predecessor in Interest has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground through pump and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T.15N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 28 bears S.61°20' E., a distance of 3,360.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions Sec. 72, Chp.140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Eureka Ranch Company
Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 6000 head of sheep and 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from April 1st to December 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 14, 1917

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from the well by means of a gasoline engine, and conveyed into troughs where it is used for the watering of 6000 head of sheep and 500 head of cattle. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
