Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Chap. 140, Stat. of 1913 ~~NRS 505.22~~, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
