CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alec J. Bailey has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 21 bears N. 73° 49' 10" E., 607.51 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 21, T.20S., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used to serve 6 homes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
