CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and fish pond for fish propagation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 17, T.36N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 17 bears N. 75° 15' E. a distance of 951.4 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 18, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped into an aerator and then into the fish pond, 8 feet by 60 feet, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for fish propagation.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
