CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Reginald G. Lee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Camp Valley Creek through weir and irrigation system for irrigation and stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 5N., R. 69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 29, T. 5N., R. 69E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 18° 17' E., a distance of 6,982.50 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.
