CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David Weir, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 21S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the center 1/4 corner of said Sec. 16 bears S. 84° 23' 29" E., a distance of 1,432.60 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

*Date of priority of appropriation November 1, 1945

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a drilled well thence pumped to a 750 room hotel and associated shops, swimming pools and recreation areas all located within the N 1/2 SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, T. 21S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes.
* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 11414, Certificate 3424, hence the priority of appropriation for this certificate is the same as Permit 11414, Certificate 3424.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
