

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. LeRoy Givens - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 16, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 45° E. a distance of 70.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Tim Hafen Ranches, Inc.
Post-office address Pahrump, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0458 c.f.s., but not to exceed 15.0 acre feet per season
Period of use, from February 1st to November 30th of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation March 12, 1959

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

3.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre feet per acre per annum from all sources.

This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Permit 25829, which in turn changes the place of use of Permit 24158, which in turn changes the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of a portion of Permit 17884. Hence the date of priority is the same as Permit 17884.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
