CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George W. Ball, Jr. - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal (Trailer Park) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 said Sec. 21 bears N. 80° 15' 07" E. a distance of 574.50 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Reno, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.19 c.f.s., but not to exceed 8.322 mga  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation January 10, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well thence pumped to a storage tank. The water is then distributed to the 80-unit Oasis Trailer Park located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The total combined amount of diversion under this certificate and the certificate issued under Permit 24318 shall not exceed 8.322 mga.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
