

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Louis G. Damonte has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 20, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 20 bears S.26°59'12"E. a distance of 2,744.30 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.446 c.f.s. but not to exceed 12.154 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 17, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is pumped from a drilled well into a 2000 gallon pressure tank thence conveyed by pipelines to 111 trailers located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 20, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
