CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy, agent has presented to the State Engineer
of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from
Bradshaw Spring
through spring and trench for
stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, T.11N.,
R.56E., M.D.B.&M., partially surveyed, or at a point from which the
SE corner of Sec. 35, T.11N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. bears S.71°00'29"E.,
a distance of 23,008.82 feet
situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date,
source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Karl Bradshaw
Post-office address Duckwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.00375 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 100 cattle
and 20 horses
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 9, 1962

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is developed at the spring and flows into a trench 50 feet
long and 5 feet deep where it is used for stock watering purposes,
within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the
amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
