

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lower Spruce Spring through pipeline and storage tank for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 31N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 27 bears S. 18° 22' E., a distance of 2274.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: West Spruce Mines Co.
Post-office address: Salt Lake City, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.089 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.089 mg annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 12, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed at Lower Spruce Spring, thence diverted 1 1/2 miles through a 2" pipeline into a 10,000 gallon storage tank in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 31N., R. 63E., M.D.B.&M. from which it is distributed to the N 1/2 SW 1/4 and S 1/2 NW 1/4 of said Sec. 21 where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
