CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul Gemmill, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12, T.1N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 11, T.1N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M. bears S.79°24'30"W., a distance of 9446.25 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 25, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed at the well, thence pumped through an 8" pipeline to a booster station thence to the place of use which is the towns of Pioche, Caselton, Prince, and Ely Valley in Sections 13 through 17, 20 through 23, 26 through 29, and 33, all in T.1N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M, where it is used for municipal purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
