CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from cut in Spring No. 1 through spring pipe and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T.19N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 9 bears N.19°50'40" W., a distance of 5,319.8 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alfred and Gracian Uhalde
Post-office address Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 2,500 sheep
Period of use, from June 1st to November 30th of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation September 22, 1922

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from the spring thence conveyed through 5300 feet of 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to a portable tank and troughs located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 9 T.19N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 300 head of cattle and 2,500 head of sheep.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 6768 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 6768.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
