

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank W. Groves has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed stream through dam for storage for fish wildlife and recreation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.3S., R.38E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 4 bears N.05°54'46"E. a distance of 1,240.90 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Amount of appropriation 30 acre feet storage

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation January 31, 1964

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

water is collected in a 30 acre foot reservoir and used for fish propagation, wildlife and recreation located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.3S., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 21773 hence the date of priority of the certificate remains the same as Permit 21773.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
