

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Sterling C. Ditsworth (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 33 bears N 82° 59' 33" E a distance of 404.11 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.925 c.f.s. but not to exceed 200.0 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
*Date of priority of appropriation March 26, 1965

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
40 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre feet per acre per annum from any and all sources.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 22509 hence the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as Permit 22509.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
