CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from North Cottonwood Spring through stock watering tank and pond for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 28, T.15N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner Sec. 34, T.15N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 36° 44' E., a distance of 11,505 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 600 cattle
Period of use, from April 15 to October 1 of each season
Date of priority of appropriation January 18, 1961

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the spring through 40 feet of 2" pipe to a 300 gallon stock watering tank, and overflow runs to a pond 50 ft. in diameter and 3 ft. deep, all located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T.15N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for stock watering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
