CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James W. Wallace has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 10, T.37N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears N. 37° 57' 40" E., a distance of 48.3 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 4.82 c.f.s., not to exceed 1280.0 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 21, 1965

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

Table with 9 columns: Area, and 8 columns for section coordinates (NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4). Rows include 39.6 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T.37N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M., and a total of 320.0 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
