CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. E. Licking has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Humboldt River (Layton Ditches) through dam and ditches for irrigation and stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 16, T.32N., R.45E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the SW corner of said Section 16 bears S. 17° 55' W., 2,725 feet and 31° 00' W., 3,760 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

This certificate changes the point of diversion of Proof 00164 under the Humboldt River Decree, hence the priority of appropriation under this certificate is as decreed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
