CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clara E. Post has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through bulldozer cut, pump and distribution system for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T.31N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 24 bears S. 35° 32' E., a distance of 1,244.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed 67.39 mgs.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 7, 1967

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced from a cut in the bed of Duck Creek thence pumped to a 100,000 gallon pond thence to the gravel washing plant located within the S 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T.31N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
