CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe B. Fallini has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cedar Spring through spring, pipe and trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T.2S., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 24 T.2S., R.51E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 77° 08' E., a distance of 15,750.93 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Joe B. and Helen Fallini and Joe B. Fallini, Jr.

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.01336 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 24, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is diverted from the spring by 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe thence conveyed approximately 9 miles to a (2 1/2'-4') x 4' by 16' trough and an earthen reservoir 80 feet by 100 feet by 6 feet deep, located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, T.2S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used to water 800 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
