CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald E. Lewis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Chris Spring through spring, pipeline and trough for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 3, T.6N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 25, T.6N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 62° 13' E. a distance of 48,582.42 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada. 1913

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Sec. 72, Ch. 140, Statutes of 1913, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 324 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 19, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is diverted from the spring by a vee intake and conveyed 200 feet through 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to a 15 foot steel stock trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 324 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
