CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, R.S. Leighton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground source through a drilled well and cooling pond for Industrial (cooling condensers for steam electric generating) and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 14, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 35°28'08" W., a distance of 16,514.59 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Sierra Pacific Power Company
Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Industrial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	5.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 729.9 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*June 4, 1960

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is delivered from the well to a cooling pond, 200 acres in surface area located within Section 36, T.15N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., from which it is circulated through condensers of the Fort Churchill steam electric generating station and then returned to the pond for cooling and reuse. Water from the well is for replacement of losses due to evaporation and percolation, and for plant domestic use.


The total duty of water allowed under this certificate and any certificate issued under supplemental Permit 26311 shall not exceed 1,757.983 million gallons annually.

*This certificate changes the place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 23203 which was issued to change the point of diversion, manner of use and place of use of water appropriated under Permit 18932, hence the date of priority of this certificate is the same as Permit 18932.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
