CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 15, T.3S., R.35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 15 bears S. 7° 53' E., a distance of 2813.47 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Conely Dairy Farms
Post-office address: via Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.11 c.f.s., not to exceed 2251.0 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year

\*Date of priority of appropriation: March 30, 1959

Table with 2 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant; and land to which the water is appurtenant. Rows list acreage and section details for Sections 9, 10, 14, 15, and 16.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 17912, thus the date of priority is the same as Permit 17912.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
