CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring No. 2 through spring, box and stock tank for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 45N., R. 56E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 32 bears S. 57° 50' W. a distance of 2,840.08 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator T. A. and Eula Mae Claridge  
Post-office address Elko, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0003125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 10 head of horses  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation October 17, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
water is collected at the spring by a 100 gallon steel box thence conveyed through 550 feet of 1" pipeline to a 100 gallon stock tank located within the same subdivision at the point of diversion where it is used to water 10 head of horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
