CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. H. Ketcham, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wild Cat Creek through dam and irrigation ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 46N., R. 35E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 12, T. 46N., R. 35E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 12° 45' E. a distance of 6,369.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator George and Eddie Mentaberry

Post-office address McDermitt, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.149 c.f.s. but not to exceed 42.0 acre feet per season

Period of use, from April 1st to July 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation January 29, 1913

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

10.5 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 18, T. 46N., R. 36E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the place of use of a portion of Permit 2622 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 2622.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
