

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James E. Schalnus, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Retain Spring through a collection box, pipeline, and watering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18, T.31N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Sec. 18 bears N.84°53'E., a distance of 1047.0 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 2000 sheep and 400 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 14, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted at the spring into a collection box from which it is distributed through 6.3 miles of 1 1/2" pipe to four 1,000 gallon watering troughs located one each within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 21, all in T.31N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for the watering of 2000 sheep and 400 cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
