CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alvin H. Fry has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hidden Treasure Spring through pipeline and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 4 of the NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 5N., R. 67E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 1 bears N. 51° 07' W., a distance of 1355.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s., not to exceed 11.4 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 3, 1961

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
2.85 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 6N., R. 67E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water for the land under this certificate shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
