CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and troughs for stock watering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 36N., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 36 bears N. 73° 33' 00" W. a distance of 4,520.7 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Blair G. and Josephine B. Johns

Post-office address Wells, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 22, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is produced from a drilled well, thence pumped through 40 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to a 2' by 2' by 20 inch trough and 200' of 1-inch to a house, both located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 500 head of cattle and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
