CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest E. Muller, Sr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and pipelines for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T.21N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 22 bears S. 11° 16' W. a distance of 1,695.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 8th to June 25th and September 15th to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 21, 1966

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: water is produced from the well thence pumped through pipelines to a mill and mining operation located within the E 1/2 SW 1/4, W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 16 and W 1/2 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 Section 22, T.21N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
