CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wallace T. Boundy, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hunter Springs through pipeline and troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T.21N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 31, T.21N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 46° 12' 30" W. a distance of 16,014.55 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bertrand Paris and Sons

Post-office address Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0466 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle and 5000 sheep

Period of use, from April 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation April 12, 1924

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is diverted from the spring by a pipe thence conveyed through 2 1/2 miles of steel pipeline and 5600 feet of 1 1/4 inch plastic pipeline to troughs located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 31 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T.21N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used to water 500 head of cattle and 5000 sheep.

*This certificate changes the manner and place of use of Permit 7083 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 7083.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
