CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

unnamed spring
through spring, box and pipeline for
domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 27, T.30N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 27 bears N. 0° 38' E. a distance of 1,284.0 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00223 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.5256 mga

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 4, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is collected at the spring by a box thence piped to a 250 gallon tank thence through a plastic pipeline, 700 feet to a trailer located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 27, T.30N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
