CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. Douglas Miller, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through reservoir and pipelines for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27, T.24N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 27 bears N. 32° 33' E. a distance of 1,668.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.134 c.f.s. but not to exceed 19.44 mga  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation August 15, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
water is collected from the spring area into a catch basin thence conveyed to a sand trap and settling tank thence by 3 inch PVC 20 feet to a 5000 gallon reservoir thence 30 feet by 6 inch flume to a reservoir thence to the places of use located within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 22 and NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 27, T.24N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
