CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe Whittle, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and municipal distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 30, T.19N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 30 bears N. 62° 34' 54" W., a distance of 1368.4 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 9, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is produced from a drilled well and is pumped to a 1,000,000 gallon concrete reservoir from which it is distributed through a water main system to the City of Fallon located within portions of Sec. 25 and 36, T.19N., R.28E., and Sec. 30 and 31, T.19N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for municipal and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
