CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Carlson Springs and Creek through headgate and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T.39N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 5 bears East, a distance of 1,980.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

*This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 8846 hence the priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 8846.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
