

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hillside Springs through a pipeline and watering troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 45N., R. 30E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 of Sec. 8, T. 45N., R. 30E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 72° 30' E., a distance of 5150 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02342 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation March 21, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is diverted from Hillside Springs within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 45N., R. 30E., M.D.B.&M., through 300 feet of 1 1/2" pipeline to a stock watering tank located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 1000 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 9230, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 9230.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
