CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, I. L. Miller, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pump, pipeline and distribution system for municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 3 (extended) Sec. 15, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 15 bears S. 6° 25' W. a distance of 2,325.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Zephyr Cove, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 2.0 c.f.s. but not to exceed 47.594 mga
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 16, 1963

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
water is pumped from the lake through a 10 inch pipeline to the distribution system where it is conveyed to 190 homes located within portions of Sections 10, 15 and 16, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., where it is used for quasi-municipal purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

This certificate is commingled with water under Permits 12997, Certificate 5420 and 16410, Certificate 5421.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
