CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gordon G. Harker has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, T.22S., R.61E., bears N. 58° 46' 07" W. a distance of 1064.0 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows.

Amount of appropriation 0.009 c.f.s. but not to exceed 4.5 acre feet per annum

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation April 9, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use
water is developed in the well thence pumped into a pressure tank thence distributed via 510' of 2" pipe to the place of use located within a portion of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 11818 hence the date of priority of this certificate remains the same as Permit 11818.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein
