 CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Glen K. Griffith, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Kingston Creek through dam and reservoir for storage for wildlife propagation and recreation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows. NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 20, T.16N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Sec. 20 bears S. 48° 34' 52" E. a distance of 2,242.0 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.82 c.f.s. but not to exceed 162.8 acre feet annually  
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

\* Date of priority of appropriation As decreed

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

water is diverted from Kingston Creek by an earth fill dam and impounded in a reservoir located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17; NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 20, T.16N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for wildlife propagation and recreation purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The total duty of water under this certificate and the certificate under Permit 24995 shall not exceed 192 acre feet annually.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 24455 which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Proof 02443 under the Kingston Creek Decree hence the priority of appropriation is as decreed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
